Attached are the Race 2 Sailing Instructions and Allocated handicaps for the Classic Yachts entered in this Summer Series for a start time of 10:30am Sunday Oct 18.

The Race will be conducted by RYCV under the direction of David LeRoy, RYCV Principal Race Officer and the Race committee vessel will be RYCV Thorsen. Call sign Royals 2.

The VHF Radio Channel used for this RYCV conducted race will be Channel 69. If a vessel retires from the race, the vessel skipper is required to notify the Race Officer on Channel 69 of this decision, as per para 10 of the Sailing instructions. Vessels that do not comply with this requirement will be scored DNC.

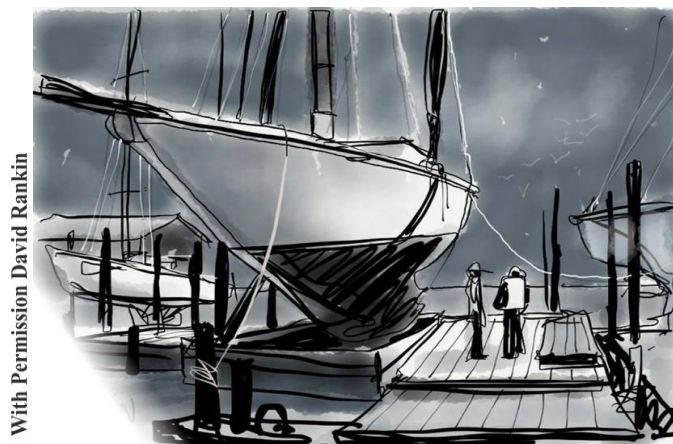
