Annually, in November the CYAA organises "The Cup Regatta". An event that brings members from Australian and New Zealand Classic Yacht Associations together in the twin bonds of friendship and Classic Yacht racing.

In 2017 "The Cup Regatta" will celebrate its 10th anniversary. Over 5 day Classic Yacht racing will be conducted in a variety of formats. The Regatta begins with Guineas Day.
