CYAA TROPHY

The skipper awarded the Tony Blake trophy will receive a cotton canvas reproduction print of the original painting and recognised on the Tony Blake perpetual Trophy



Awarded to the Classic Yacht with the lowest aggregated point score over the Cup Regatta and the previous Summer and Winter race series.

Trophy points are based on a double regatta points score and the 2018 Winter Series and current 2018 Summer Series points score.
