### Extract from Race 1 Sailing Instructions

#### 11.1 Starting Line

The Pursuit Start Line shall be an imaginary line between the Flag Staff of the RYCV Starting Box located on the Northern End of the RYCV Marina and Mark O, a plain orange special purpose mark located approximately 200m to the North.

(Initial Course direction is to the East).

The SCHEDULED group starting time for each boat is on the list of entries.

The ACTUAL starting time for each group is when their group number is removed from display on the RYCV Race Committee starting box.

Please note additional course instructions for Pursuit Race Marina Start and Finish

After starting, and prior to sailing the assigned course, yachts shall pass through the gate formed by the No. 20 Channel Pile and the Northern end of the Workshops Pier.
