Subject: RYCV COVID 19 - Requirements for Race Days

Dear Members

Firstly, let me introduce myself as I have recently taken up the position of Sailing Manager in the office at the club. It is good modern race management practice to be available to the competitors with an aim to improving the clubs racing and the enjoyment of the many. I plan to make myself thus available.

Unfortunately, this correspondence does not cover listening but to impart the requirements, placed on the club by authorities, that will permit us to keep sailing.

1. On race days and when there are larger social gatherings we are required to have a COVID Check-in Marshall present at all entrances to our facility, to monitor compliance with the directions of the Acting Chief Health Officer of Victoria by all of those entering. We envision at least one COVID Check-in Marshall, and sometimes two, to be present in the car park as the place where most enter the club. Similar to when we first re-opened last year.
2. For those that enter our facility the directions of the Acting Chief Health Officer require that everyone log in with the Service Victoria QR code. Please cooperate by showing the COVID Marshall the green tick Current check in on the app when asked. If you do not have a device to do this it can be achieved on the Kiosk Check-in at the office.
3. As with everywhere in Victoria you must carry a face mask with you at all times, the mask should be worn indoors and outdoors unless an exception applies such as eating, drinking, and strenuous activity.
4. Members should not congregate in groups greater than 10 but Australian Sailing advises that if your yacht requires more than 10 to operate safely then this is an exception.
5. Shared Equipment such as the controls of club cranes should be cleaned between use.
6. There will be density limits for the club indoors based on one person per 4 square meters
