1 Rules

- 1.1. The Regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in the Australian Sailing Racing Rules of Sailing (RRS) 2021-2024.
- 1.2. Vic Port Corporation 11th edition May 2019 in particular Section 2.14 Page 20 applies to this event <http://www.vicports.vic.gov.au/publications/Documents/hm-directions-10th-edition.pdf>
- 1.3. RRS Racing rule 44.1 will be changed as follows:
The two turn penalty is replaced with a one turn penalty.
This change will appear in full in the Sailing Instructions of all Cup Regatta races.

2 Advertising

- 2.1. Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority and host club.

3 Eligibility and entry

- 3.1. The 2022 Cup Regatta series of races is open to Classic Yachts and Coutu Boats as determined by the CYAA Executive. Entries must be listed on the register of a Yacht Club affiliated with Australian Sailing.
- 3.2. Entrants must submit the 2022 Cup Regatta entry form using the Top Yacht Entry System to the Royal Melbourne Yacht Squadron (RMYS) by COB Wednesday 26th October 2022.
- 3.3. Late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Organising authority.

4 Fees

- 4.1. All race entry \$200.00. Individual race entries \$50 per race
- 4.2. Optional social event fees TBA at a later date.

5 Schedule

- 5.1 Date of racing.
All divisions 29th to 31st October 2022. No lay day scheduled
- 5.2 Number of races.
All Classes 2 races first two day
Pursuit Start race final day
- 5.3 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race first two days is 1025 hours. 10:55am for final day.

6 Sailing Instruction

- 6.1. The sailing instructions for this Cup Regatta will be the 2022 Cup Regatta Sailing Instructions issued 1st October 2022.

7 The Courses

- 7.1. The courses to be sailed will be described in the sailing instructions

8 Penalty System

- 8.1. The penalties are as follows for all divisions.
- 8.2. For all divisions rule 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn penalty.

9 Scoring

- 9.1. The scoring system is as follows.
- 9.2. Two completed races are required to constitute a series.
- 9.3. When two or more races have been completed a boats series score will be the total of her race scores.
- 9.4 Club team scores shall be the combined total of the series scores for each boat in the team in the series. The lowest team score wins

10 Support Boats

- 10.1. Support boats will be marked with a RYCV burgee.

11 Radio Communications

- 11.1. Except in an emergency, a boat shall neither make radio transmissions while racing nor receiver radio communications not available to all boats. This restriction also applies to mobile phones.

12 Prizes

- 12.1. Subject to at least three entries per division and team received, the following Trophies shall be awarded at such time decided by the organizers.
- 12.2. **COL BANDY TROPHY** Awarded to the Classic Yacht with the lowest aggregated points score for four 2022 Cup Regatta division start races.
- 12.3. **TONY BLAKE PERPETUAL TROPHY.** The trophy deed of gift stipulates a copy of the perpetual trophy be awarded to the Classic Yacht with the best performing points score aggregated over the four 2022 Cup Regatta division start races and over the immediate past Summer and Winter Series. Double performance points score is activated for 2022 Cup Regatta events.
- 12.4. **STRADBROKE II TROPHY** Awarded to the Couta Boat with the lowest overall aggregated point score for the four 2022 Cup Regatta division start races.
- 12.5 **MAKING WAVES FOUNDATION TROPHY.** Awarded to the home club team with the lowest scoring points
- 12.5 **RMYS UIRA TROPHY** Awarded to the first Tumblaren home in the 2022 Cup Regatta pursuit start race.
- 12.6 **RGYC DIGBY FAMILY TROPHY** Awarded to the best performing classic yacht in the 2022 Cup Regatta from Corio Bay.
- 12.7. **CONCOURS d'ELEGANCE TROPHY** for the smartest and ship shape Classic Yacht that competed in the 2022 Cup Regatta.

13 Disclaimer of Liability

- 13.1 Competitors participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk. See AS RRS 2021-2024 Rule 4, Decision to Race. The organising authority and Ports Victoria will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the 2022 Cup Regatta.

14 Insurance

- 14.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of \$10,000,000 per event or equivalent.
