A celebration of Kingurra's 50 years of yacht racing will be held on Sunday, with her entry in the Classic Yacht Association summer series race 5. Afterwards, **Kingurra** will return to her home at Royal Brighton Yacht Club to continue the celebration.

RMYS will conduct race 5 from the RMYS Race tower.

Repeat

Race 5 will be conducted from the RMYS Race Tower.

Our Summer Series race 5 will be conducted from the RMYS Race Tower using RMYS courses. Not far from the on-water location from where RYCV intended to conduct Race 5.

The scheduled race 5 warning signal is 0955 hours on Sunday 11th December. The first group will start at 1000 hours. With the current forecast of 15 knot northerlies for Sunday I expect to be using RMYS Course 64. Start G C E A G A E Finish All marks to port

RMYS Squadron fleet race

A RMYS fleet will be competing in a Squadron pursuit race on Sunday. 1100 hours is the scheduled start time.. To minimise mark rounding clashes I expect this fleet to be assigned RMYS Course 7. Start D G B E Finish. All marks to port.

These expected course assignments for both races are based on forecast weather and can change.

Race 5 start time details

The forecast Race 5 conditions are expected to be similar to those experienced during race 4.
